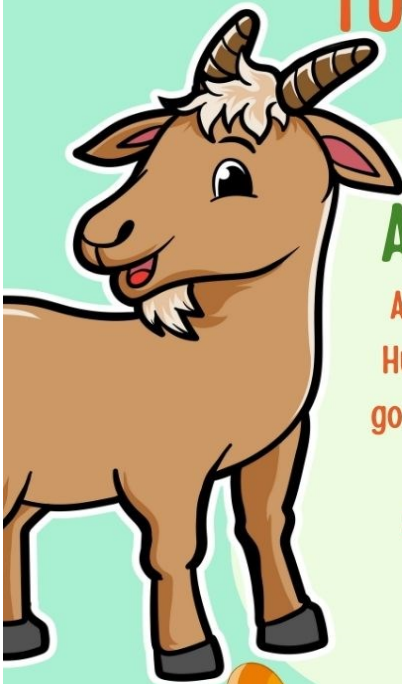


A fully interactive Easter Egg hunt
